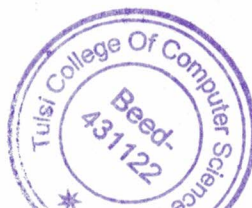
Objectives

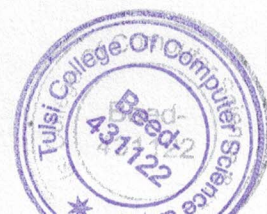
