The event saw participation from over 32 students, faculty members, and local community members. Feedback collected from attendees indicated a high level of engagement and interest in the subject matter.

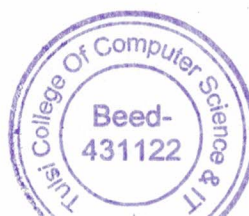
Outcomes
