Strong scholarship Assistance to All Category Students

1: Vision, Priority and Thrust areas of the institution are as given below

Vision: The college strives to provide a comprehensive and rigorous education that prepares rural and local socio-economic backward students for successful careers in various industries. It envisions being a hub for innovation and research.

Mission are

1. To offer cutting-edge courses and state-of-the-art facilities that enable students to explore emerging technologies and gain hands-on experience.
2. It fosters a culture of collaboration, creativity, critical thinking, innovation and encouraging students to work on interdisciplinary projects and pursue research that addresses real-world challenges.
3. Aims to produce graduates who are not only skilled but also possess the ability to think critically, communicate effectively, and solve complex problems creatively.

The college's priority is to educate local & rural area students who belong to weaker socio-economic backgrounds by ensuring excellent computer knowledge & continuous improvement in character building. The college has been focused on creating interest/awareness in the students related to I.T. sector and give them information about the job/career opportunities, develop entrepreneur skills in students.

2: One distinctiveness and its significance

Strong scholarship assistance is the distinctiveness of the college. The college has been trying to create awareness about all scholarships among all students and also motivate and encourage them to apply for scholarships. Along with providing basic knowledge about how many types of government scholarships are available which offer funds and also eligibility criteria for the respective scholarships. The college staff members try to solve the basic problems related to scholarships of the students.

The college is giving I.T. based education to rural area students by the courses like BCA, BCS, BSc, MMS & MSc comp. Most enrolled students belong to the rural area as well as low-or middle-

class families. So the college has to guide every student about all government scholarships because it may be helpful to solve the economic problems of needy students. Mostly considered scholarships such as Government of India [GoI] Scholarship, Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj Scholarship for open category students, SWAYAM scholarship scheme for Nomadic Tribes [NT-C] category students' scholarship, Maulana Azad National Scholarship for minority students, SWADHAR Yojana & Central Sector Scholarship scheme for open category students etc. For attaining scholarships and their related issues the college gives responsibility to staff members starting with giving basic information about every scholarship scheme to students up to filling up the scholarship forms of all eligible students for the concerned scheme every year and ending when students get the scholarships.

3: Description to support distinctiveness

The college has taken initiative in this activity because the mostly enrolled students belong to the rural area as well as low or middle-class families. The college considers that economic crises must not be barriers in the process of success. The student might not afford various types of university or college fees. That's why the college is trying to solve the student's economic crises with the help of all types of scholarships which will be provided by the state and central government.

According to most of the students' opinions, one of the hardest parts of applying for a scholarship is finding an appropriate scholarship program for themselves. Again, they have to find the required documents for the scholarship application. This document preparation is an important and critical task. Most of the documents are required from government authorities. Our staff members guide and help in collecting necessary documents. The starting & ending date to fill the scholarship forms of all schemes is conveyed to the students from time to time by notice or media displays. All necessary documents and supporting documents are also conveyed to the students. There are so many technical problems that may be faced by the students while applying for the scholarship such as creating user name/ID and passwords, (Also there are many chances to forget password), online registration, scanning documents and uploading them with required size. We know that it is easy to recreate passwords but students are not aware of that process. Therefore, our college has given responsibility to fill-up online scholarship forms of eligible candidates to the staff members in the college by using college IT infrastructure. Continuous follow up is also taken for the remaining students so as they might not be skipped from scholarship. The college staff members

help in any problem regarding scholarship form filling such as AADHAAR linkage, document verification, mobile or bank account updation etc. Some scholarships require permission from the Principal which is given to them very easily. Strong scholarship assistance is maintained throughout the year.

4: Feedback from stakeholders

The feedback was taken from the beneficiary with the help of personal discussion and questionnaire. Random Sampling technique is used to get the feedback. The college has started this scholarship assistance for all scholarship holder students. Most of the students belongs from the rural area and they did not know about the scholarships which is available from the central as well as state government for the students. That's why the college is giving information about all scholarships available and applicable to eligible students. It's clearly understood on the basis of personal discussion with beneficiary students that all students of the college are really satisfied with this activity which is run by the college.

Outcomes

The 62% students had taken benefits and tried to complete their education during the last five years from total numbers of students.
